He also appealed that instead of destroying the opium fields, the cultivators should be made aware first about the ill effects of poppy cultivation.

"Thereafter, they must be advised to discontinue the farming from the next season with complete support for them to grow alternative cash crops like cardamom and oranges," Pul added.
