

# APWWS wants female officer in probe

ITANAGAR, Jun 16: The Arunachal Pradesh Women's Welfare Society (APWWS) while reacting to the news of alleged molestation of a female colleague by DRC Kolkata has said that since it a case under Sexual Harassment at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal Act 2013), has sought inclusion of a female officer to have a fair enquiry according to the prevailing law.

While lauding the lady for coming up with the complaint, the Society said that

it needs a lot of courage to speak about such incidents when the perpetrator is the employer himself.

Meanwhile, Society has reiterated its demand to the government for setting up redressal cell in every department so that immediate steps are initiated against any wrongdoers who take advantage of female employees. It further expressed its serious concerns about safety and security of female employees under various government and semi-government establishments.
